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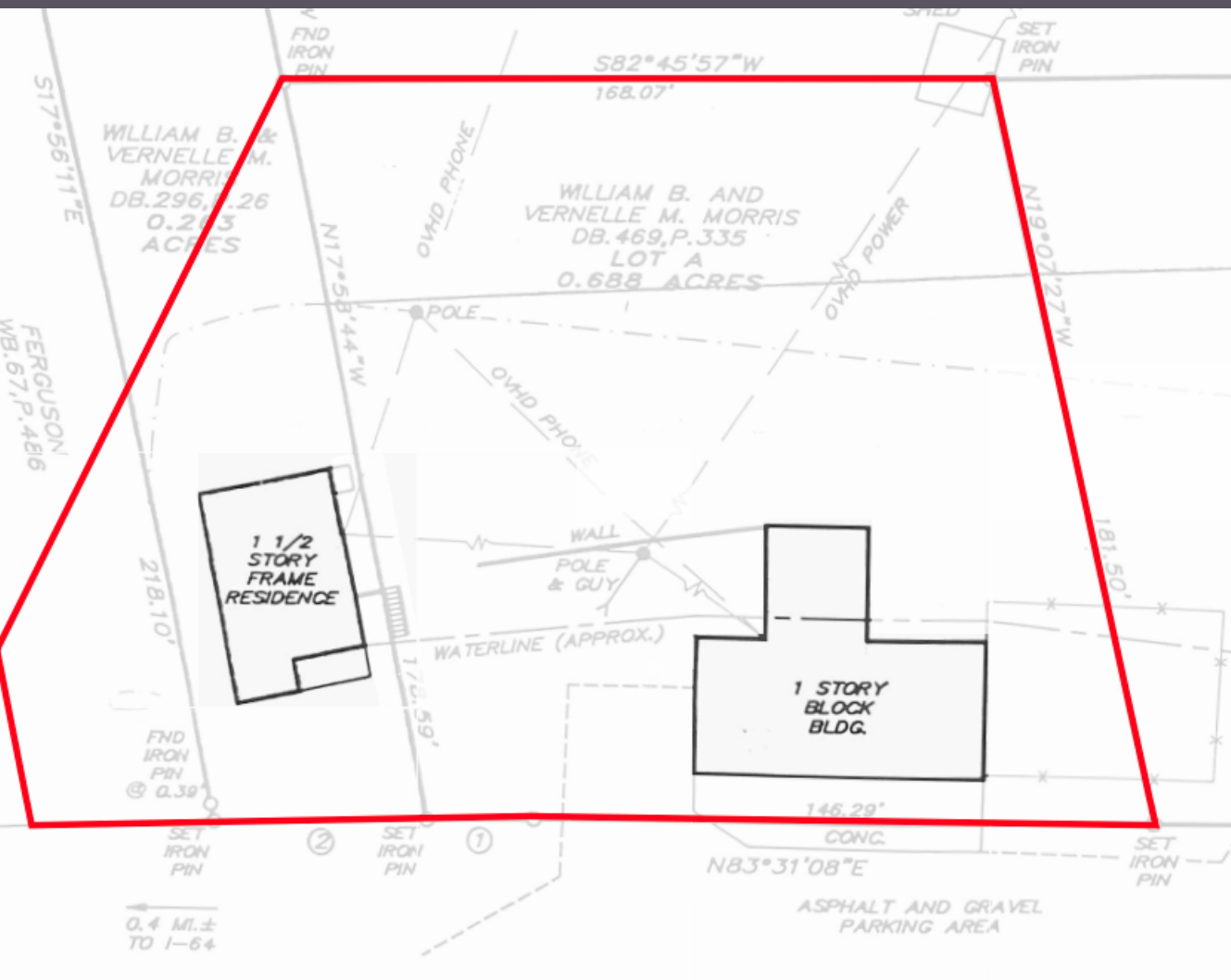

# Request

## **BUILDING HISTORY - GROCERY**

- Built as fruit sale “hut” around 1957
- Expanded from 1960-1990
- Fire 1999
- Rebuilt 2003 as non-conforming Class A Country Store
- Class A Country Store regulations adopted 2008, established Greenwood Grocery as Class A Country Store

## **BUILDING HISTORY - RESIDENCE**

- Occupied by Basil and Vernell Morris 1951-1999
- Sold fruit from a picnic table and pickup truck in yard
- Used as primary sales location for county store following grocery fire in 1999
- Building permit B202402501AR submitted 8/20/2024 for Residential Alterations
- Stop work order on building permit to determine grocery use status via LOD
