**Description:**

This request is to appropriate \$500,000 in local revenue from the City of Charlottesville to the Water Quality Mandated Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) project in the Storm Water Capital Program. Funding from the City is part of the signed agreement between the City and the County in relation to nitrogen credits from the Biscuit Run Stream Restoration project. Water Quality Mandated TMDL funding will be used to support future water quality projects, including additional stream restoration projects.

All funds will be used exclusively for opioid abatement in compliance with Virginia Code and applicable settlement requirements.
