

A Special Closed Meeting of the Albemarle County School Board was held on May 18, 2009 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 320 of the Albemarle County Office Building, 401 McIntire Road, Charlottesville, VA 22902.

Call to Order

At 5:36 p.m., Mr. Wheeler called the meeting to order.

Closed Meeting.

Mr. Price offered a **motion** to go into Closed Meeting as authorized by the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, section 2.2-3711(A) of the Code of Virginia under subsection 2 to discuss and consider the readmission of an expelled high school student. Mr. Koleszar **seconded** the motion, **and the motion passed with Mrs. Moynihan absent.**

Certify Closed Meeting.

At 6:13 p.m., Mr. Price offered a **motion** that the Board certify by recorded vote that to the best of each Board member's knowledge, only public business matters lawfully exempted from the open meeting requirements of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and identified in the motion authorizing the Closed Meeting were heard, discussed or considered in the Closed Meeting. Mrs. Moynihan **seconded** the motion. **Roll was called, and the motion passed by the following recorded votes:**

Motion carried by a 5:0:2 vote.

Mr. Price offered a **motion** to allow student number 1 to continue receiving alternative educational services through his IEP for the remainder of the 2008-2009 school year. Deny the student readmission into the school division for placement in the regular education setting for 2009-2010 school year but allow him to receive alternative educational services through his IEP during the 2009-2010 school year. Mrs. Moynihan **seconded** the motion, **and the motion passed.**
