

TUTORING FOR PAY

Tutoring for Pay

Any staff member associated with the instruction of students may not be paid for tutoring students enrolled in a class under his/her direction except under the following circumstances:

- (1) The instruction is provided as part of a division sponsored or division approved program and with the consent of the principal; or
- (2) The instruction is provided after normal contract hours and as part of an approved homebound instruction program.;

Staff may be paid for privately tutoring students, other than those in their classes, at their own discretion, but they may not do so on school premises.

Tutoring for Credit/Homebound

The School Board does not permit the tutoring of students for credit except in the homebound instruction program and under the direction of the administration. Only those students who are physically unable to attend school may be tutored for credit.

~~Teachers may be paid for privately tutoring students, other than those in their classes, at their own discretion but not upon the school premises or for credit.~~

~~Teachers may, however, be paid for homebound instruction provided after normal contract hours if the student has been approved under the homebound instruction program.~~
