

BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY AND DUTIES

The School Board is a body corporate and, in its corporate capacity, is vested with all the powers and charged with all the duties, obligations, and responsibilities imposed upon School Boards by law. ~~and~~ The Board may sue, be sued, contract, be contracted with, and purchase, take, hold, lease, and convey school property, both real and personal. School Board members shall have no organization or duties except such as may be assigned to them by the School Board as a whole.
