Secondly the Basketball Court be names the A.P. Moore – Walter Green Gymnasium (again with appropriate signage).

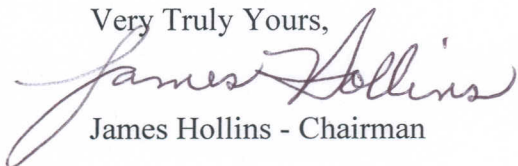
To quote Coach Clarence Jones "We set records and Field Championship Teams because our major focus was building men".
