

SAMPLE SCHOOLNET CASES

Scenario # 1

During the middle of the 3rd quarter, you have a student who has performed very poorly on their most recent assessments. You are wondering if this is a pattern of negative performance in your class and others and/or part of a bigger issue with this particular students.

How would you use SchoolNet to gain valuable information to help answer this question?

Scenario # 2

Your 2nd quarter assessment data shows that overall only 60% of the 3rd grade students meet proficiency on the cumulative Mathematics test. How is the performance of particular membership groups contributing to these results? Does a particular teacher have significantly lower or higher results? Which standards were assessed?

How would SchoolNet help you answer these questions?

Scenario #3

You are a 1st year teacher and unsure of what the Framework for Quality Learning is and how it relates to the individual content areas. How can you use Schoolnet to access the Division's curricular framework and get examples of sample lesson/unit plans?

Scenario #4

The Division piloted MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) testing this year. What is MAP testing, what does it measure, and how would I read the score reports?

How would SchoolNet help you answer these questions?

Scenario #5

I need to read the latest version of the Superintendent's Advisory Bulletin and the Division Compass. How would you use SchoolNet to access the informative internal publications?
