

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

~~The Board may provide for the necessary transportation of students. The Board requires that all conditions stipulated by the Code of Virginia and regulations of the Virginia Board of Education for transportation of students be met so that the Board may receive all state funds due for the transportation of students.~~

The School Board may provide for the transportation of students. All conditions regarding the transportation of students stipulated by the Code of Virginia, regulations of the Virginia Board of Education, and policies and regulations of the School Board shall be met. Students may be suspended from using school transportation services for violations of the Standards of Student Conduct or when the student endangers the health, safety and welfare of other riders or Board employees. In such cases the parent or guardian shall be responsible for transporting the student to school.

The Superintendent is authorized to permit the fueling and servicing of other Division or eCounty-owned vehicles in the Vehicle Maintenance Facility ~~bus shop~~. Other County departments must reimburse the ~~at no expense to the~~ School Board for fuel and service expenses.
