

QUORUM

At any meeting of a School Board, a majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum. No actions can be taken by the Board without a quorum. Should a quorum not be assembled at the hour appointed for the meeting, the members present shall be competent to adjourn in order that an opportunity may be given for a quorum to assemble.

Presiding Officer

At the hour and place for the meeting, the Chairman, or in his absence the Vice-Chairman, or in his absence a member elected by the members present, shall assume the chair and shall declare the meeting in order.
