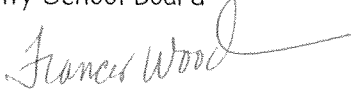

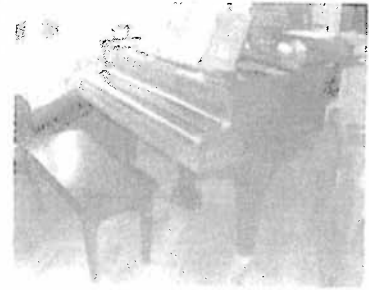
Line Item 1

Description: Piano, grand, ca.1906, American, by *Baldwin Piano Manufacturing Co. of Cincinnati, Ohio, Acoustic Patented Construction*, serial number *H 54880*, winner *Prix Paris 1900*, *Grand Prize St. Louis 1906*, mahogany; included a rectilinear lift-top bench 18 1/2"H 36"L 15"D.

Dimensions: 38 3/4" height, 56 7/8" width, 60" depth

Condition: Very Good

Comparables: Baldwin grand pianos have demand in the marketplace, based on my experience, on recent observations in the *relevant market*, and on conferring with a specialized expert.²

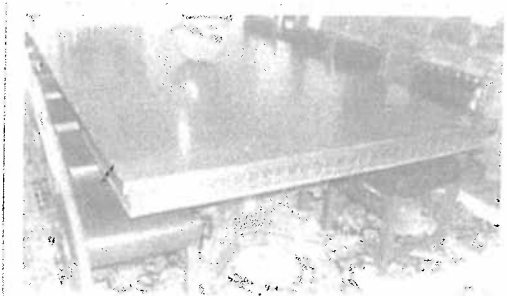
Description: Table/banquet, ca.1880-1900, American, walnut, maple *secondary*, square top extends with 13 leaves to become rectilinear, leaves are 12" flat 5/4" thick boards, carved frieze, supported on two massive splayed pedestals with animal paw feet and a square center support, pedestal ends separate to reveal a hidden square pedestal when the top is pulled apart for additional leaves, rests flat on *plinth* base, original patina.

Dimensions: 30 3/8" height, 59 1/4" square, add 12" per leaf

Condition: Very Good / absent one ten inch carved element to pedestal at one end, UV fading³

Comparables: Large banquet tables of this type have demand in the marketplace, based on my experience, on recent observations in the *relevant market*,⁴ and on *secondary market* comparables.⁵

Descriptions: Chairs, matched set of 13 consisting of four arm chairs and nine side chairs, American, walnut, straight back, scalloped *stile* finials, red leather backrest and tight seat, open arms supported on turned setback supports, square seat, supported on four square legs, turned *superior* anterior stretcher, square bilateral *inferior* stretchers, bold brass-head tacks, original patina.

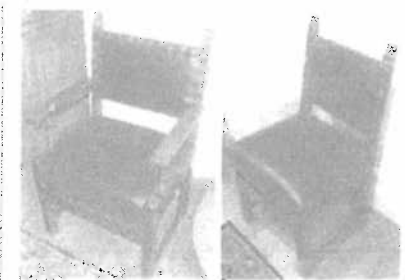
Dimensions arm chairs: 39 1/4" height, 22 3/8" width, 20 1/2" depth

Dimensions side chairs: 37" height, 18" width, 18" depth

Condition: Very Good (all)
