Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

2015



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Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency, annual household income, race/ethnicity, age and sex.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are “real.” Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for this report is generally no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for the entire sample (375 completed surveys). For subgroups of responses, the margin of error increases because the sample size for the subgroup is smaller. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Within Governance, residents with household incomes \$50,000 to \$99,999 rated Albemarle County, the job Albemarle County government does at welcoming citizen involvement, overall confidence in Albemarle County government and treating all residents fairly lower than those making \$100,000 or more and those making less than \$49,999. Residents who had lived in the County for 11 or more years rated general aspects of Governance lower than those who had lived in the County for 10 years or less.
- Hispanic and/or other race residents and residents aged 18-34 years gave lower ratings to police services, fire services and ambulance or emergency medical services than residents who were white alone, not Hispanic and residents 35 or older.
- Participation ratings, particularly those within Community Engagement, tended to be lower for residents aged 18-34 years. Those residents reported a lower rate of participating in a club, attended a local public meeting, reading or watching local news and contacting Albemarle County elected officials. Opportunities to participate in social events and activities, openness and acceptance of the community toward people of diverse backgrounds and neighborliness of residents in Albemarle County were rated lower by Hispanic and/or other race residents than white alone, not Hispanic residents.
- Within Mobility, rates of participation for walked or biked instead of driving, carpooled with other adults or children instead of driving alone and used bus, rail, subway or other public transportation were the lowest among residents 55 and older. Residents who had lived in the County for 11 or more years and those with household incomes of \$100,000 or more were the least likely to use bus, rail, subway or other public transportation instead of driving.
- Within the facet of Recreation and Wellness, residents with household incomes of \$100,000 or more gave the highest ratings to health and wellness opportunities in Albemarle County, fitness opportunities, recreational opportunities, availability of affordable quality health care and availability of preventive health services.
