

BOARD MEMBER OATH OF OFFICE

Prior to participation in the first Board meeting in the term for which he/she is elected, the newly elected member of the School Board shall take the oath of office prescribed by state law for officers of the state. Failure to take the oath of office within the time allowed by law renders the office vacant.

~~School Board members fulfilling unexpired terms of office must take the oath of office before serving in the first School Board meeting.~~

Any person, whether appointed or elected in a special election, to fill an unexpired term of office must take the oath of office prior to beginning his/her duties as a school board member.
