<u>CURRENT</u>	<u>PROPOSED</u>
1. Definitions include many “content-based” types.	1. “Content-based” definitions have been removed or changed.
2. Sign types listed individually in several sections.	2. Sign types have been consolidated.
3. Sec 4.15.6 Signs Exempt from sign permit, list many content-based sign types with separate standards.	3. Sign types have been grouped by size and made content neutral.
4. There are six regulations tables in 4.15.8 – 4.15.14 with notes at several.	4. Reduced to three tables with notes at each.
5. Sec 4.15.16. Regulations by sign types list different standards for different signs.	5. Sec. 4.15.16 has been deleted and standards are captured where appropriate in definitions.
6. Temporary sign heights are 10 feet in some districts and 12 feet in others.	6. Temporary sign heights have been standardized to 12 feet for ease of administration and clarity for public.
7. Temporary wall sign heights are 20 ft. or 30ft.	7. Temporary wall sign heights go to “not to exceed cornice” in C-1 districts or beyond to be consistent with permanent wall signs ion those districts.
8. Wall signs can be 40 sq. ft. in RA & MHD, 20 sq. ft. or 32 sq. ft. in other residential districts.	8. Make all wall signs 40 sq. ft. max in RA, MHD and Res. Districts for consistency.

NOTE: Highlighted proposed items 6 – 8, are the items the Planning Commission recommended be left unchanged from the current ordinance
