

SUPPORT SERVICES GOALS

The Board recognizes that the non-instructional business operations and planning functions of the school system are essential yet ancillary and auxiliary to support systems for the primary function of the school system, which is education. To fulfill these this secondary but important functions, it is the intention of the Board to:

- A. Ensure the proper operation and maintenance of school buildings, vehicles, equipment, and services; to provide safe and efficient pupil transportation; to set high standards of safety; to promote the health and nutrition of pupils and staff; and to maintain a healthy environment. to reflect the aspirations of the community; and to support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide good instruction.
- B. Encourage through the Superintendent and staff the establishment of efficient and effective businesslike procedures for the management of buildings and grounds, offices, transportation services, vehicles, equipment, supplies, and the food program.
- C. Encourage the establishment of a thorough, effective, and economical maintenance program, including preventive maintenance, that will ensure a useful life of school property, vehicles, buildings, and equipment.

~~D. Encourage the adherence to generally accepted management principles and applicable laws and regulations when establishing policies and regulations in these areas.~~
