

GROUPING FOR INSTRUCTION

The Albemarle County School Board recognizes the different educational needs of students and endorses the use of flexible assignment of students for instruction.

The grouping of students within individual schools for instructional purposes ~~will~~ shall be designed so each student will receive the maximum instructional benefit and will be based on:

1. the interests of the student,
2. the educational level, or achievement level of the student,
3. the learning style of the student,
4. the availability of space,
5. the best ~~an effective~~ educational climate for learning, ~~and~~
6. the student's opportunity for success, and
7. the creation of groups that may be taught effectively.

Grouping ~~shall~~ will remain flexible in order to take advantage of educational research currently available. Groups will be created, modified, or disbanded to be responsive to student needs.
