

SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Generally

~~Summer school programs shall be administered under the direction of the Superintendent/Designee. Summer schools shall be designed to enrich the education of students and to permit students to earn credits needed for graduation or promotion.~~

~~The summer school program shall be equal in quality to that offered during the regular school term. State Board of Education requirements for an accredited summer school shall be met.~~

Eligibility

~~———— The Superintendent shall require students who are educationally at risk to attend special programs of prevention, intervention, or remediation. A student's poor academic performance, performance on the *Standards of Learning* and other state tests, or promotion may necessitate the student's attendance in summer school, as determined by the Superintendent/Designee.~~

~~———— Any student who does not achieve proficiency on the state testing program shall be required to attend a summer school or participate in another form of remediation. The requirement for remediation may, however, be satisfied by the student's attendance in a program of prevention, intervention or remediation which has been selected by his parent in consultation with the Superintendent/Designee and is either (i) conducted by an accredited private school or (ii) a special program which the Superintendent determines to be comparable to the required public school remediation program. The costs of such private school remediation program or other special remediation program shall be borne by the student's parent.~~

~~———— The Superintendent may seek immediate compliance with the compulsory school attendance laws if reasonable efforts have failed towards improving the student's attendance, including direct notification of the parents or guardians of such student.~~

Fees

~~High school summer school programs shall be financed by fees as approved by the School Board.~~
