

FUND RAISING AND SOLICITATIONS

Fund Raising

Fund-raising efforts shall be authorized under conditions that do not conflict with instructional programs. Fund-raising refers to the raising of non-appropriated money for the educational benefit of students and their schools.

Fund-raising shall be permitted by students provided such activities are approved in writing and carefully monitored and regulated by the school principal or designee. Students may not be involved in any door-to-door solicitation.

Each principal shall develop and maintain a list of all fund-raising activities.

No fund-raising shall be approved for any school activity until the activity has been approved.
