

An adjourned meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Albemarle County, Virginia, was held on December 1, 2015, at 6:00 p.m., Room 241, County Office Building, McIntire Road, Charlottesville, Virginia. The meeting was adjourned from November 11, 2015. The purpose of the meeting was to allow a quorum of the Board to attend the Thomas Jefferson Planning District Commission's Legislative Forum to discuss the TJPDC's and the County's legislative priorities.

Mr. Blount presented information on local revenue authority and regional legislative priorities including the impacts to localities of continued unfunded mandates and the basis for the region's decision to seek equal taxing authority of cities.
