² 4 Full-Size Classrooms are currently being used by the Charter School (They also use 105-b, but that is not counted as a classroom in Burley’s capacity calculation). The Charter School currently has 39 students, but is projecting staffing for 45 students next year. The program is designed to have 8-10 students per class. The enrollment figures for Burley do not reflect students enrolled in the program; the building capacity does not omit room for the program, either. Subtracting those four rooms, Burley’s capacity would be 638.

³ Murray High School is not reflected in this chart. The program currently has a target enrollment of 110 students. It utilizes 12 classrooms & the gym in the building.
