

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS MANAGEMENT

School division properties will be maintained in good physical condition: safe, clean, sanitary, and as comfortable and convenient as the facilities will permit or the use requires.

The Superintendent will have the general responsibility for the care, custody, and safekeeping of all school property, establishing such procedures and employing such means as may be necessary to discharge this responsibility.

At the building level, the principal in conjunction with Building Services will be responsible for overseeing the school plant and for the proper care of school property by the staff and students.

The school division shall maintain documentation of any pesticide application that includes the target pest, the formulation applied, and the specific location of the application.
