Adult Basic Education Programs ~~are may be~~ offered to those ~~residents members~~ of the ~~school division over the age of compulsory attendance who are not enrolled in the regular public school program and who are functioning below the high school completion level.~~ ~~community who have not successfully completed the eighth grade or higher.~~ The School Board seeks to ensure that every adult participating in such a program has the opportunity to earn a general education development (GED) certificate or a high school diploma. Such programs may be conducted solely by the School Board or through a collaborative arrangement between the School Board and other school boards or agencies. Additional educational programs for adults also may be offered. ~~In addition, a General Education Development Program for adults who have not earned a high school diploma and who wish to prepare for the General Education Development Program Examination may be offered. Additional educational programs for adults may be offered.~~ Tuition and fees are established by the School Board~~may be charged.~~
