





BAP : Behaviors that Impede the Academic Progress (BAP) of the student or of other students




BESO : Behaviors that Endanger Self or Others (BESO) These behaviors endanger the health, safety, or welfare of either the student or others in the school community.




BSC : Behaviors of a Safety Concern (BSC) create unsafe conditions for students, staff, and/or visitors to the school.




BSO : Behaviors related to School Operations (BSO) interfere with the daily operation of school procedures



RB : Relationship Behaviors (RB) create a negative relationship between two or more members of the school community (No physical harm is done.)

BESO : Behaviors that Endanger Self or Others (BESO) These behaviors endanger the health, safety, or welfare of either the student or others in the school community.


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

Focus of Student Services for 23-24

1. **Model and support** the increased utilization of **restorative practices** within the schools.
2. **Increase the integrity of the data** to support data driven decision making by calibrating reporting practices across the system of schools within the division.
3. **Increase** other indicators (positively) **as a result of an alignment of Student Services** (i.e. restorative practices, focus on increasing accessibility of mental health and physical health services).






This is a quick synopsis of how students are supported through our school counselors and in comparison to how many referrals are sent to our community based services.




Community Based Referrals








9.4% of ACPS students in our middle schools have seriously considered attempting suicide.




HIGH SCHOOL RESULTS
