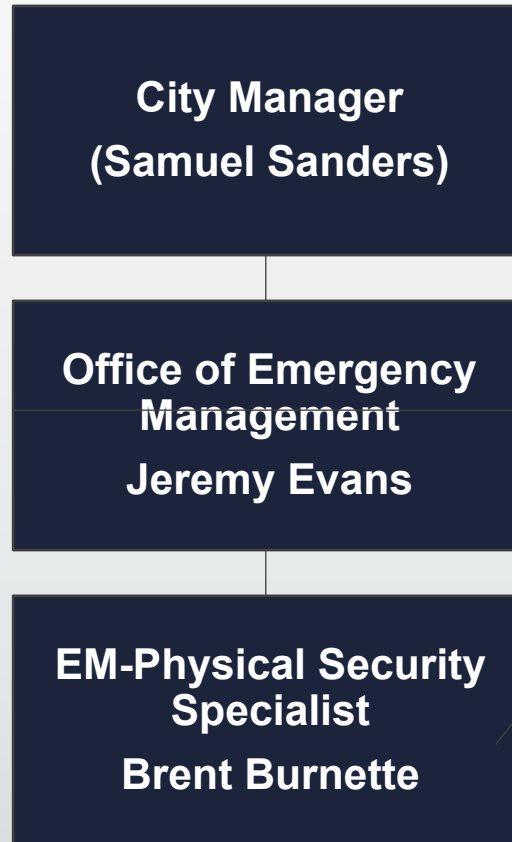
Office of Emergency Management
