

Educational Technology Policy

The School Board recognizes that educational technology can enhance teaching and learning, expand access to educational resources, support communication and collaboration, and promote the development of digital literacy skills. The Board also recognizes the importance of balancing technology use with students' developmental needs and milestones by ensuring opportunities for direct instruction, reading, writing, discussion, hands-on learning experiences, physical activity, and interpersonal interaction.

The purpose of this policy is to establish expectations for purposeful and developmentally appropriate use of educational technology and student screen time in the school division.
