

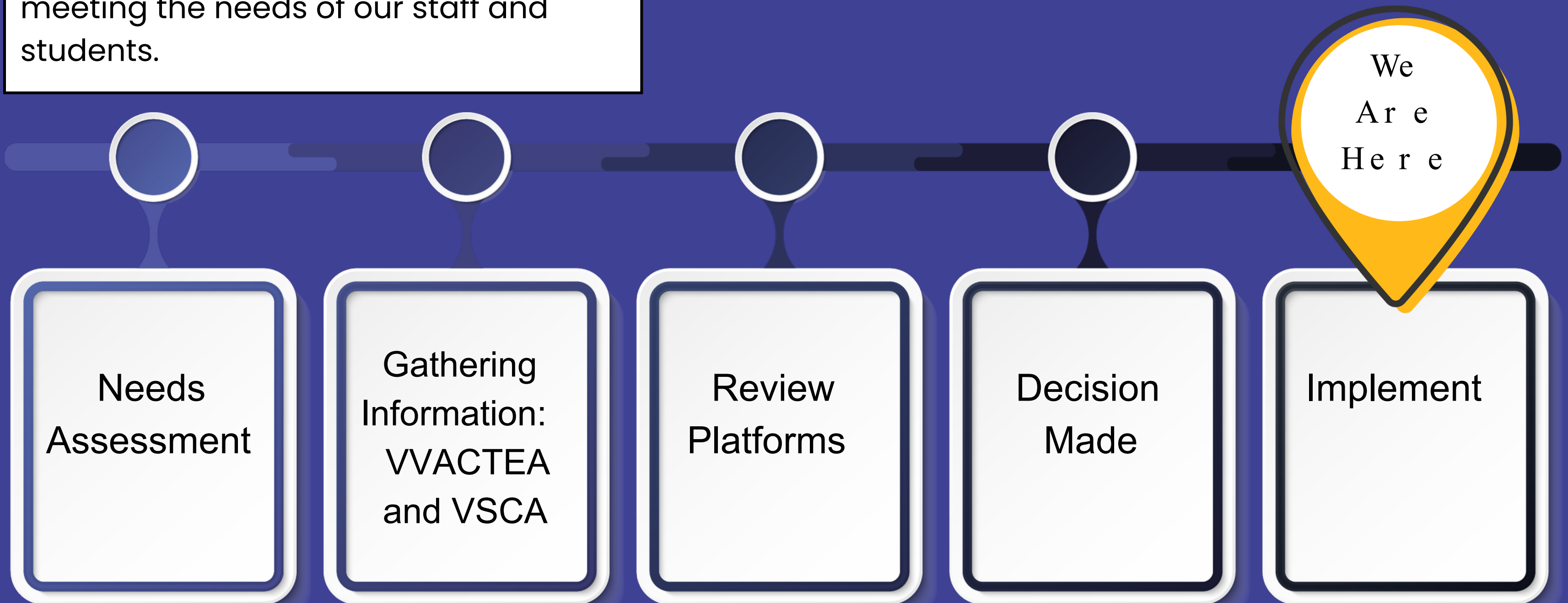


College & Career Readiness

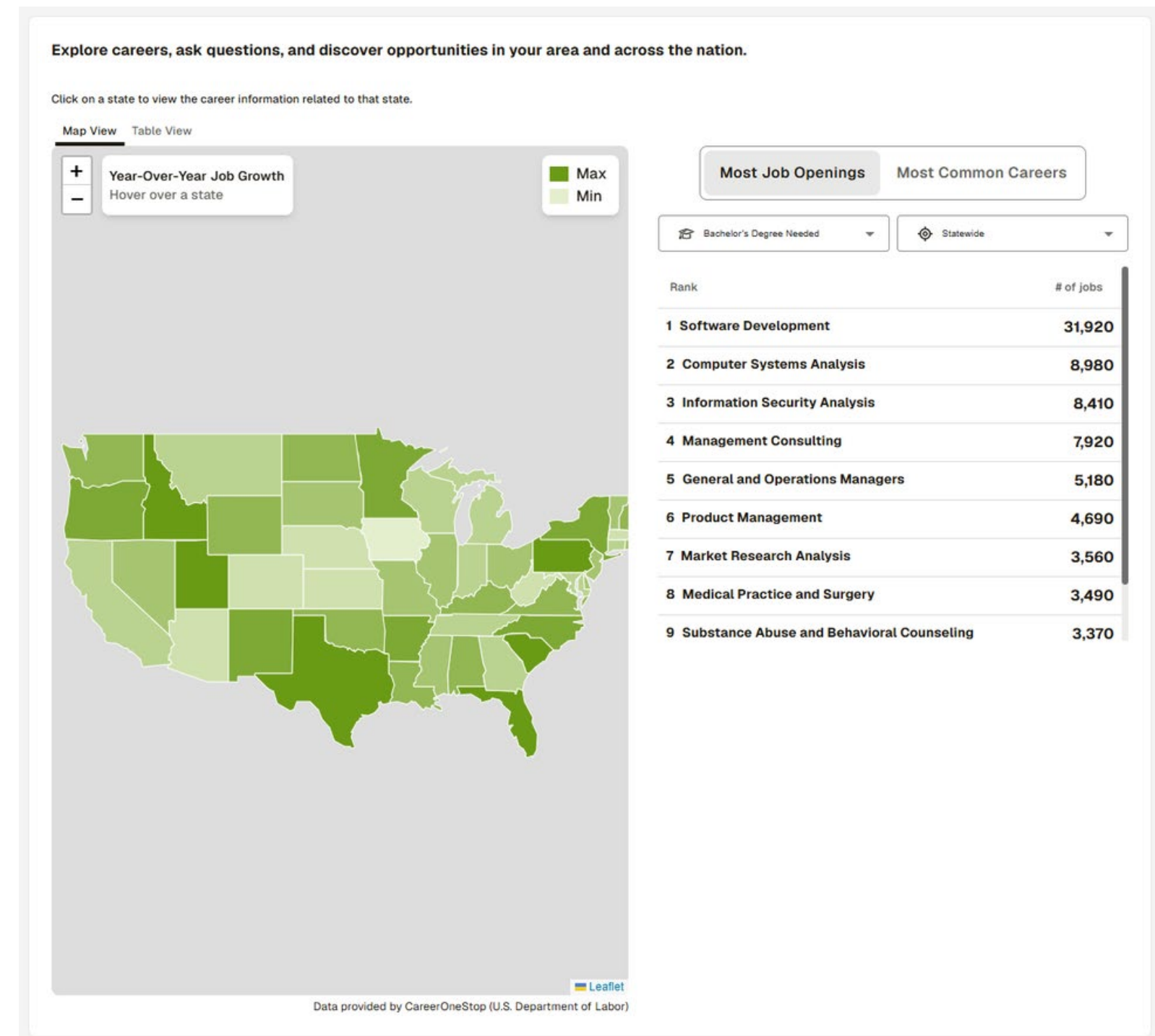
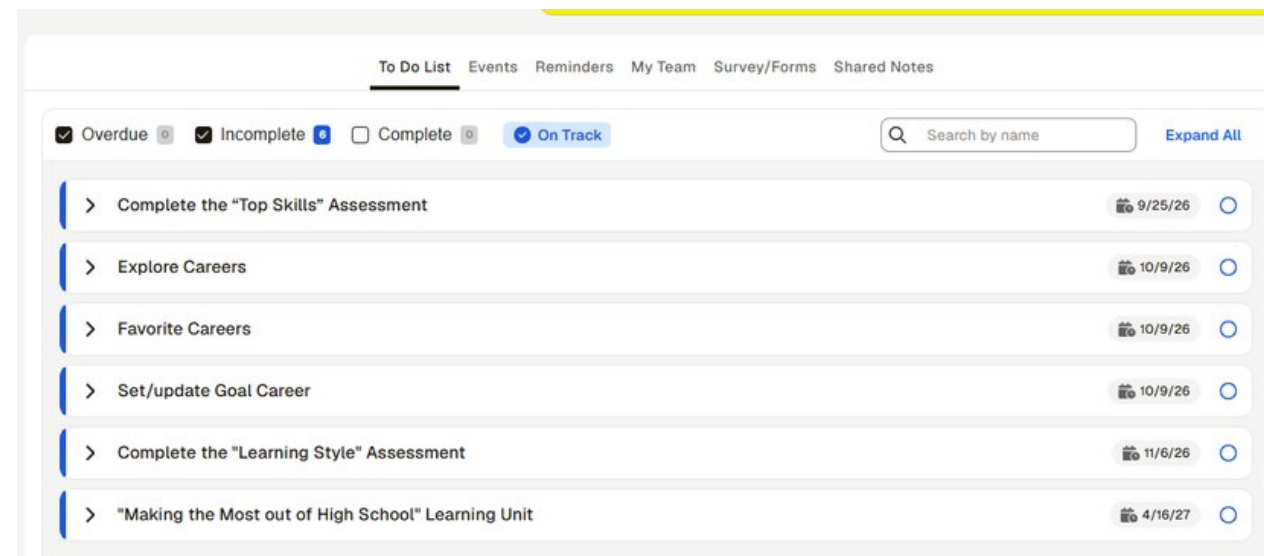

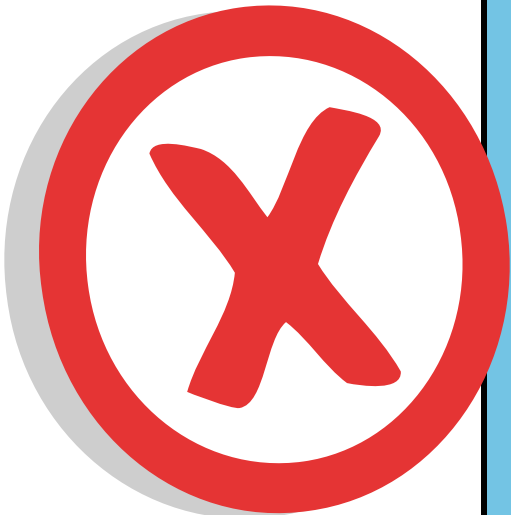

Add Electives

Students add electives, and other classes such as Health/PE and World Languages. It will track sequential electives.

Sequential Electives

You must take 2 credits of courses that are sequential meaning the content increases or expands in scope from the first to second credit. These courses are set up in SchoolLinks to enforce the proper ordering. If you do not select two related courses in the right order, the requirement will not be met. Courses cannot both satisfy graduation requirements AND the sequential elective requirement. The other graduation requirements must first be met. Exception to this is that 1 credit of a Fine Arts or CTE course can overlap.
