SUBJECT: **Approval of project submission for Smart Scale Round 6**

DATE: June 9, 2026

Every two years each locality has an opportunity to submit projects for funding from VDOT through the Smart Scale application process. The projects must be part of a Corridor of Statewide Significance. In order for the project to score high enough to receive funding it must improve safety, reduce congestion, improve travel time, and/or preserve capacity on the roadway.

Staff has met with VDOT to identify projects for this submission. The recommendation is to submit the projects reviewed and approved for submission by the Board of Supervisors for Smart Scale Round 5 in 2024. The projects are 1) US 29/616 (Carpenters Mill Road)/Commerce Drive improvement project will modify a 0.61-mile corridor with existing median crossing into Innovative Intersections, as recommended in a safety and operation study completed by RK&K, to help facilitate safer movements crossing US 29, and 2) US 33/Greenecroft BLVD/Advance Mills Road improvement project will modify a 0.4-mile corridor by closing the two existing full access intersections at Advance Mills and Greenecroft and adding U-turn only crossings at the east and west ends of the project.

The Smart Scale process requires a resolution of support from the Board of Supervisors. Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution for the two qualifying projects.
