

RESOLUTION OF INTENT

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS desires to explore the establishment of a private airport and helipad on County-owned property for the testing and operation of unmanned vehicle systems and related technologies; and

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS finds that evaluating such a use may support economic development, public safety, and technological innovation within Greene County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS hereby directs staff to identify suitable County-owned property and prepare the information necessary for consideration of a Special Use Permit application for a private airport, helipad, and unmanned vehicle testing and operations facility; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission shall review the proposed use, hold any required public hearings, and make its recommendation to the Board of Supervisors at the earliest possible date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is directed to bring forward any necessary applications, notices, and supporting materials for Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors consideration.
