

**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE NEXT
GENERAL REAL ESTATE REASSESSMENT
AND ALLOW THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO
PROCURE A FIRM TO PERFORM THE WORK**

WHEREAS, the Code of Virginia §58.1-3252 requires counties to perform a general reassessment of real estate every four years at a minimum; and

WHEREAS, the County of Greene has opted to hold it every two years; and

WHEREAS, the last reassessment was held in 2025; and

WHEREAS, the next reassessment should be held in 2027; and

WHEREAS, the County needs to procure a Firm for the reassessment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Greene, Virginia that the County will hold a general reassessment of real estate in 2027.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Administrator of the County of Greene, Virginia is authorized to post the Request for Proposals to find a Firm to perform the work.
