Monthly Report for January 2026

On January 31, 2026, Greene County had 16,375 registered voters. Statistics by precinct are as follows:

Dyke: 1,429 registered voters
Swift Run: 2,438 registered voters
Ruckersville: 4,147 registered voters
Stanardsville: 3,799 registered voters
Stanardsville Town: 229 registered voters
Midway: 4,333 registered voters

Greene County will hold three or four elections during 2026:

Tentatively, there will be an election on April 21, 2026. The Proposed Virginia Constitutional Amendment question on the ballot is:

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?

The June 16, 2026 Primary may still occur for U.S. Senator, or it might be moved to July or Aug.

If the above amendment passes on April 21, 2026, the U.S. Representative primary race will be moved to July or Aug.

There will be a November 3, 2026 election for U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, and voters in Stanardsville Town will vote for Mayor and Council Members. Tentatively, the At-Large Board of Supervisors will also be on the ballot as a Special Election.
