

Monthly Status Report

Greene County Water + Sewer Department

Capital Projects

Alum Feed at WWTP is almost complete. Substantial completion notification issued to contractor, and Certificate to Operate received from DEQ, effectively completing consent order.

Raw Water Line has started construction with staking of route on 29/Fredericksburg corner. Last two easements on Vista Heights Drive are being finalized. Neighborhood meeting was well attended and appreciated.

Intake/Pump Station has started construction with clearing of riverbank and construction of access road.

Reservoir Dam is under redesign.

New Water Treatment plant is under redesign.

Stanardsville WWTP Closure is at 60% design.

Well #2 is designed and in permit review.

Stanardsville water improvement project received a \$1.1 million Federal grant.

Office

With staff shortages, handing new assignment of taking cash/check payments, addressing payment delinquencies, renewing vendor contracts. Presentation of Budget recommendation focused on long-planned user fee rate increase and much-needed Senior Accountant position.

Water Treatment Plant

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, focusing this month on SCADA monitoring of inputs and outputs, and coordinating with Intake/Pump Station construction. Starting work on Emergency Relief TA with federal grant.

Wastewater Treatment Plant

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, focusing this month on newly restored clarifier tank, drainage around building, office toilet, starting alum feed, and reinstalling missing gate valve.

Water Distribution & Wastewater Collection

No major breaks this month. Staff continue to focus on reviewing designs for new construction, organizing routine maintenance and starting GIS mapping of system.

Caroline Sherfey started as Wastewater Plant Operator. Gage Berryman received his Class 3 Water Treatment License. Bill Fortino received his Class 2 Water Treatment License. Tom Morgan received his Class 2 Water Treatment License. Cross training between all four divisions continues in earnest.
