

## **Monthly Status Report**

### **Greene County Water + Sewer Department**

**April 21, 2026**

#### **Capital Projects**

Alum Feed at WWTP is complete. Certificate to Operate received from DEQ, effectively completing consent order.

Raw Water Line has been installed on Route 29 and half of route on Fredericksburg Road. Staff is working with designer, developer and neighborhood on possible reroute to avoid building in most of the Vista Heights subdivision.

Intake/Pump Station has continued construction with removal of sludge from existing pond..

Reservoir Dam is under redesign.

New Water Treatment plant is under redesign.

Stanardsville WWTP Closure is nearing final design.

Well #2 is designed and in permit review.

#### **Office**

With staff shortages, handing new assignment of taking cash/check payments, addressing payment delinquencies, renewing vendor contracts.

#### **Water Treatment Plant**

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, focusing this month on SCADA monitoring of inputs and outputs, and coordinating with Intake/Pump Station construction. Completing work on Emergency Relief TA with federal grant.

#### **Wastewater Treatment Plant**

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, as well as processing sludge removed from water treatment plant for Intake/Pump Station project

## **Water Distribution & Wastewater Collection**

Break by private construction contractor working in the Industrial Drive right-of-way resulted in low of pressure to customers nearby and in Stanardsville. Staff responded near perfectly to this unusual disruption of service and reporting to customers.

Staff continue to focus on finding covered valves, reviewing designs for new construction, and starting GIS mapping of system.

## **Personnel**

Cross training between all four divisions continues in earnest. We have applied for a VaCO award for this program. Plant operator staff members continue to gain higher State licensing levels.
