DEPARTMENT REPORTS & ACTION ITEMS

1. RECREATION SUPERVISOR POSITION RECRUITMENT & HIRING PROCESS

The Department continued to move forward with the recruitment and hiring process for the vacant Recreation Supervisor position. This position has remained open for an extended period of time, with several qualified applicants progressing through the interview and selection process. While the search has taken longer than initially anticipated, the Department remains committed to finding the right candidate who aligns with the mission, values, and operational needs of Greene County Parks & Recreation. The additional time spent throughout the process has allowed for careful consideration of applicants and ensures the selected individual will be positioned to provide quality leadership, support program growth, and strengthen the Department's ability to serve the community.

2. COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS & FUTURE RECREATION DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES

Greene County Parks & Recreation continued strengthening its partnerships and collaboration efforts with Impact Greene, Greene County Planning & Zoning, and the Ruckersville Advisory Committee throughout June. Ongoing discussions with these community partners have focused on identifying future recreation needs and exploring opportunities to enhance quality-of-life amenities for Greene County residents. A primary area of discussion has been the draft concepts and proposals being developed by the Ruckersville Advisory Committee for presentation to the Board of Supervisors regarding the potential development of an indoor recreation facility. The opportunity to explore an indoor recreation facility represents an exciting potential investment in the future of Greene County Parks & Recreation and

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the community as a whole. We appreciate the collaboration and forward-thinking approach of Impact Greene, the Ruckersville Advisory Committee, and community stakeholders involved in these conversations.
