

Monthly Status Report

Capital Projects

Raw Water Line has been installed on Route 29 and Fredericksburg Road, and continuing on Vista Heights Drive. (If you haven't been out there, check out their good work.) The proposed line has been redesigned and rerouted to avoid building in front of most of the Vista Heights subdivision homes, to the pleasure of the homeowners.

Intake/Pump Station is continuing construction with excavation proceeding.

Reservoir Dam is under redesign.

New Water Treatment plant is under redesign.

Stanardsville WWTP Closure is being bid for construction over the next few weeks.

Well #2 is designed and in permit review, and will be bid for construction soon.

Office

Past payment delinquency work is complete and up to date. Several accounts dating back for three years have been successfully resolved.

Water Treatment Plant

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, focusing this month on repairing broken tank valve, replacing the obsolete SCADA system and coordinating with Intake/Pump Station construction. Completing work on Emergency Relief TA with federal grant.

Wastewater Treatment Plant

Staff continue to repair and upgrade equipment and processes, as well as cross-training with water plant personnel.

Water Distribution & Wastewater Collection

Staff continue to focus on clearing large easements, finding covered valves, reviewing designs for new construction, and starting GIS mapping of system.

Personnel

Cross training between all four divisions continues in earnest. Greene County has won the state-wide small county VaCO award for this program. Plant operator staff members continue to gain higher State licensing levels.
