

**ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 4-3-2 PROHIBITION ON
PROCUREMENT OF USE OF AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE
RECOGNITION SYSTEMS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
CITY OF HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA**

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Harrisonburg, Virginia:

Section 4-3-2 be enacted as follows:

Section 4-3-2 Prohibition on Procurement or Use of Automatic License Plate Recognition Systems by City

a) Definitions. For the purposes of this Section:

- 1) “Automatic license plate recognition system” or “ALPR system” has the meaning assigned to it in § 2.2-5517 of the Code of Virginia, as amended.
- 2) “Procure” includes any purchase, lease, rental, subscription, license, service agreement, grant-funded acquisition, donation, trial arrangement, pilot program, or other agreement or arrangement, whether monetary or nonmonetary, by which the City obtains goods, services, equipment, software, data, access, or operational capability.
- 3) “Stationary ALPR camera” means an ALPR system, or any camera or other component of an ALPR system, that is installed or placed at a fixed location, whether permanently or temporarily. The term includes a camera placed on a post, building, structure, or traffic control device. The term does not include an ALPR system mounted on a motor vehicle or a photo speed monitoring device, as defined in § 46.2-882.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, that is used only for the purposes authorized by that section.

b) Prohibition. The City shall not:

- 1) Procure any stationary ALPR camera;
- 2) Install, place, mount, maintain, or use any stationary ALPR camera at any location; or
- 3) Enter into, renew, extend, or continue any contract or agreement for any stationary ALPR camera.

c) Exceptions. Nothing in this Section prohibits:

- 1) The use of an ALPR system that is not a stationary ALPR camera;
- 2) Access to or use of a stationary ALPR system by employees of the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Emergency Communications Center; or

- 3) Receipt of information generated by a stationary ALPR camera owned or operated by another person or entity, if the information is not received under an agreement or arrangement prohibited by this Section.
