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**A RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND REAPPOINTMENT OF MS. SUSAN FLETCHER  
TO THE LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) is established pursuant to § 15.2-2308 of the Code of Virginia to hear and decide appeals, variances, and special exceptions under the County's zoning ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, appointments and reappointments to the Board of Zoning Appeals are made by the Circuit Court Judges upon recommendation of the Board of Supervisors, and such appointments are for five-year terms as prescribed by Virginia law; and

**WHEREAS**, Susan Fletcher currently serves as a member of the Louisa County Board of Zoning Appeals, and her current term is set to expire on April 12, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Fletcher has expressed her desire to continue serving and is eligible for reappointment; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Fletcher has demonstrated commitment, experience, and sound judgment in carrying out the duties and responsibilities of a BZA member during her current term;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 2nd day of February, 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby recommends to the Circuit Court Judges of Louisa County that Susan Fletcher be reappointed to serve as a member of the Louisa County Board of Zoning Appeals for a new five-year term in accordance with Virginia law.
