**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATION TO  
JUVENILE PROBATION FOR ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDS FOR VJCCCA  
PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice has recently awarded an additional \$6,000 in Virginia Juvenile Community Crime Control Act (VJCCCA) funding to the County of Louisa for Fiscal Year 2025: and

**WHEREAS**, this funding is used to serve juveniles who are experiencing violence and conflict in school and home, who are truant, or need help in transition from out of home placement back to the community and provide support to deter youth from further involvement in the juvenile justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no additional funding required for maintenance of efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, this additional funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 budget and needs to be appropriated at this time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 2nd day of June 2025, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes a pass through appropriation in the amount of \$6,000 for the VJCCCA funding as follows:
