RT. 714 IN LOUISA CO. TO CLOSE FOR BRIDGE REHABILITATION

Traffic will use signed detour through August 30

CULPEPER — Beginning Monday, June 23, a segment of Route 714 (Horseshoe Farm Road) in Louisa County will be closed to through traffic for a bridge rehabilitation project. The existing structure is located roughly one mile from Route 604 (Roundabout Road) and 1.4 miles from Route 208 (Courthouse Road).



During the work, through traffic will use a signed detour around the closure via Routes 208, 646 and 604. Access to driveway entrances on either side of the closure will be maintained for local traffic. Message boards were installed June 9 to alert drivers.

The Virginia Department of Transportation's Louisa bridge crew will replace the steel beam timber deck and replace it with a concrete box culvert.

The bridge is currently posted at 24 tons and is 13.7 feet wide. The new structure will be capable of carrying all legal loads with an increased width of 21 feet.

Work is expected to be complete by Aug. 30, weather permitting.
