**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATION FOR
INSURANCE PROCEEDS**

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$1,228.06 for damages to a 2021 Pierce Pumper; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$5,627.10 for damages to a 2020 Jeep Compass that was damaged at the diverging diamond on Route 15 when another vehicle failed to yield the right away; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$2,854.15 to a deputy's vehicle that was hit by a deer and \$3,841.59 for a parked car that was hit in the County parking lot; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$101,790.92 for a 2020 Ford and its equipment that was totaled in a vehicle accident; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$122,500 for damages to a 2023 Ford ambulance that was sideswiped by another vehicle as it was passing it; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$18,363.14 for damages to a 2016 Ford Ambulance that was involved in an incident during a February snowstorm; and

WHEREAS, funding for the above incidents was not included in the FY 2025 budget and needs to be appropriated at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on this 4th day of August 2025, that the Louisa

County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes a pass through appropriation to the FY 2024 budget as follows:
