RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATION TO FIRE & EMS FOR THE RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS GRANT

WHEREAS, the jurisdictions surrounding the North Anna Nuclear Power Station must prepare for potential emergencies involving the power station; and

WHEREAS, Dominion Resources, through the Virginia Department of Emergency Management, provides emergency preparedness funding to each locality surrounding the North Anna Power Station; and

WHEREAS, \$36,000 was recently allocated to the County of Louisa specifically for the following projects: \$11,900 for the maintenance of the CivicPlus Mass Notification System, \$11,000 for the maintenance of Veoci Emergency Management Software related to plans and record keeping as related to the NAPS and \$13,100 for a Decontamination Tent for Radiological Emergency; and

WHEREAS, these items were specifically approved by the Virginia Department of Emergency Management and meet the requirements of the Code of Virginia § 44-146.33 of the Radiological Emergency Preparedness Fund regarding the capabilities to deal with nuclear incidents; and

WHEREAS, this funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2026 budget and needs to be appropriated at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on this 1st day of December 2025, the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes a pass through appropriation in the amount of \$36,000 for emergency preparedness, as follows:
