Dear Chairman Adams,

Section 62.1-44.15:4 of the Code of Virginia requires the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to notify localities and adjoining landowners when a permit application is received. This is to inform you that DEQ has received an application for a Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) permit from Amazon Data Services, Inc. The applicant proposes to discharge non-contact cooling water from a proposed data center (Lake Anna Tech Campus) located at the corner of Kentucky Springs Road (Virginia Route 652) and Haley Drive in Mineral, VA. The Department will review the application and may draft a permit for this discharge. If the Department drafts a permit a notice will appear in *The Central Virginian* announcing our intention to issue the permit and inviting public comment on its content. This public comment period will run for 30 days from the date the notice first appears in the newspaper. In the meantime, you are welcome to review the permit application at our office by appointment or by requesting an electronic copy.
