**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MARK FOSTER TO PURCHASE HIS SERVICE  
HANDGUN**

**WHEREAS,** Mark Foster has served more than 25 years serving the citizens of Louisa County; and

**WHEREAS,** Mark Foster has served the public with over 23 years as a sworn law enforcement officer; and

**WHEREAS,** § 59.1-148.3(A) of the Code of Virginia states: Any officer who at the time of his retirement is a full-time sworn law-enforcement officer, who meets the qualifications outlined in subsection A, even if a portion of this service was with another law enforcement agency, may purchase the service handgun issued to him by the agency from which he retires at a price of \$1.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** on this 2nd day of September 2025, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize Mark Foster to purchase his service handgun for the price of \$1 upon his retirement.
