**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
COMMONWEALTH ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR THE VICTIM WITNESS GRANT**

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth Attorney and the Victim Witness Coordinator have applied and received funding from the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services for the continuation of the Victim Witness Assistance Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount of this Grant is \$81,440.00, which consists of Federal and State Funds and it does not require a local match; and

**WHEREAS**, this Grant assists in funding a full-time Coordinator that is employed by the Commonwealth Attorney's Office and certain program expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2026 budget and needs to be appropriated at this time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on this 2nd day of September, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby approves a pass through appropriation in the amount of \$81,440.00 for the Victim Witness Program, allocated as follows: Compensation and Benefits of Victim Witness Coordinator \$78,708 (GL #20222100-411010-C2202) and Victim Witness Program expenses \$2,732 (GL #20222100-458409-C2202). The source of this funding is State Crime Witness Assistance (GL #0202R24-324040-C2202) \$44,385 and Federal Crime Witness Assistance (GL #0202R32-332010-C2202) \$37,053
