**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND EMS TO APPLY FOR A
RESCUE SQUAD ASSISTANCE FUND GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF PATIENT CARE
VENTILATORS**

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire and EMS is requesting approval to apply for a Rescue Squad Assistance Fund Grant (RSAF) through the Virginia Office of EMS (OEMS) for up to \$47,500 to purchase patient care ventilators; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the ventilators is up to \$95,000; and

WHEREAS, the matching requirement for the grant is a 50/50 match, or \$47,500; and

WHEREAS, the equipment would improve the level of service provided by the Department of Fire & EMS by equipping units with state-of-the-art equipment to improve patient outcomes; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on this 16th day of March 2026, the Louisa County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of Fire & EMS to apply for a Rescue Squad Assistance Fund Grant in an amount up to \$47,500 with a local match of up to \$47,500 to be used to purchase patient care ventilators for a total cost of up to \$95,000. The source of the match would be the general fund balance.
