Department Overview:

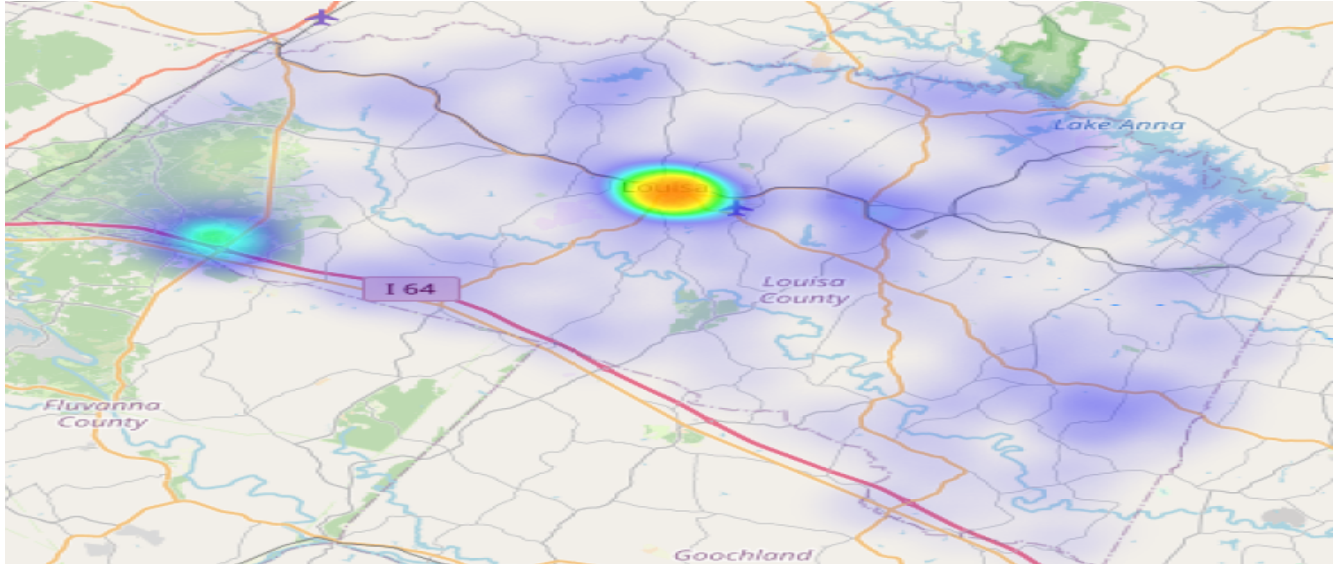

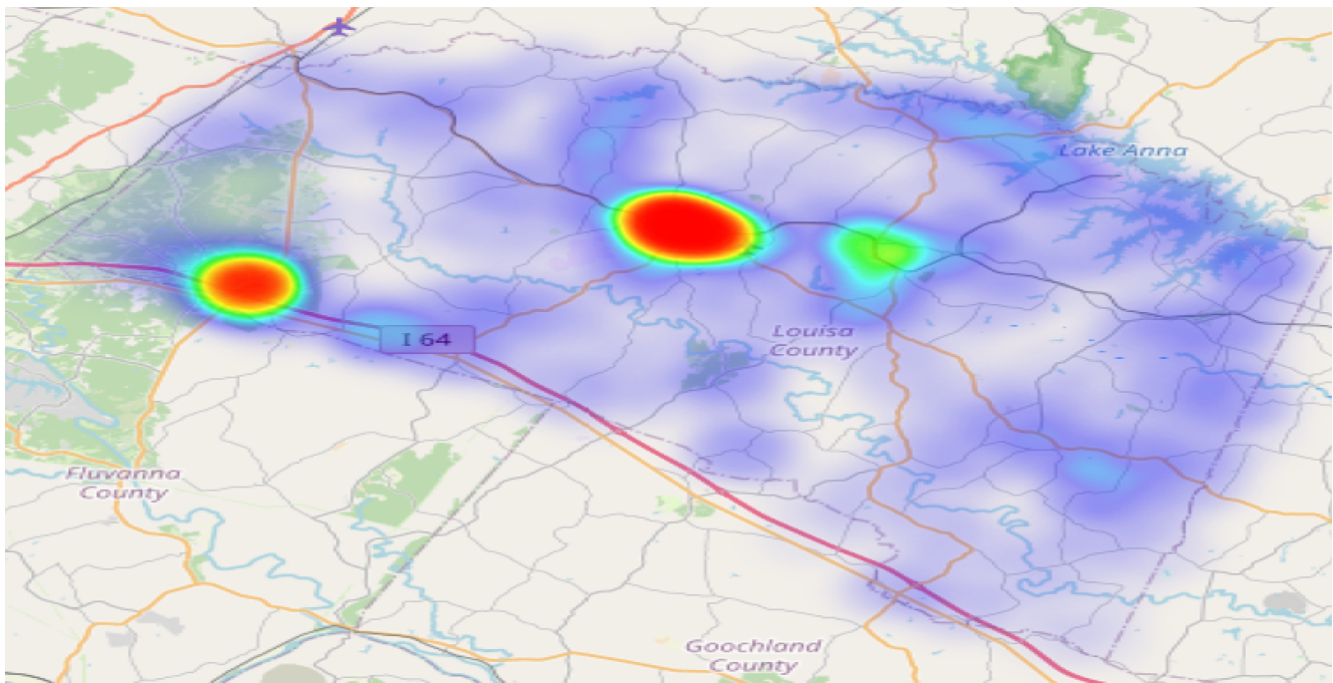

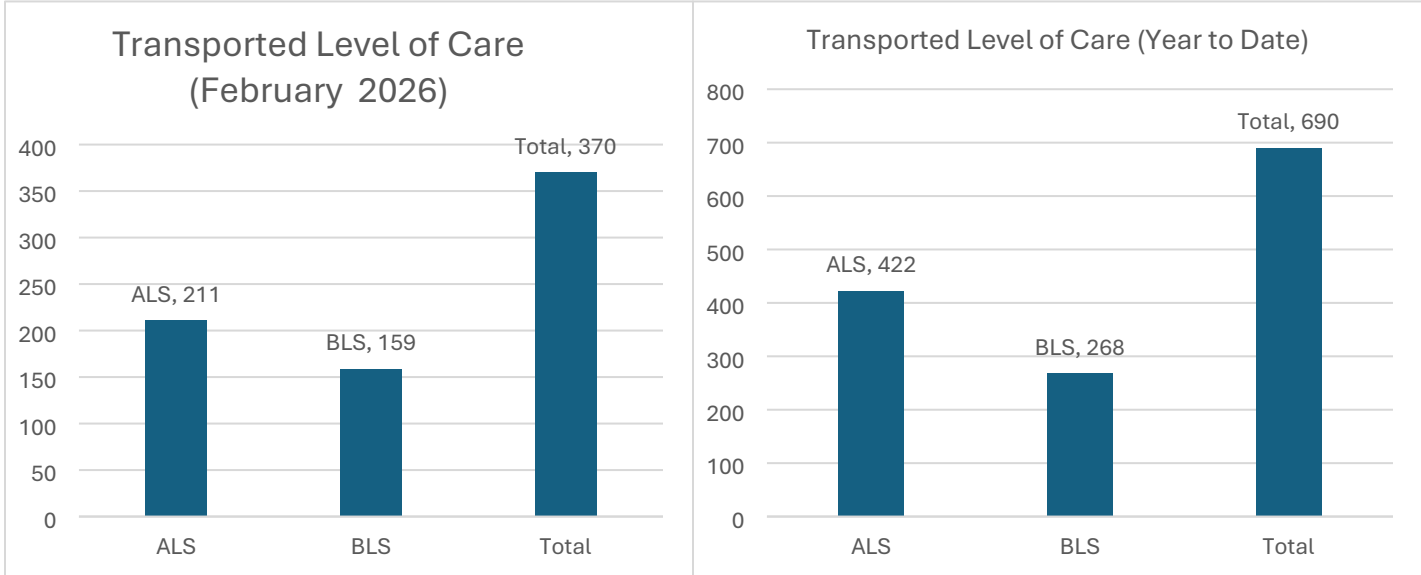
February 2026 Heat Map of Incidents

Grants, Capital, and Other Updates:

Grants Updates:

- RSAF TJ-C05/12-24 (50/50 for Medications and Lockers): Medication lockers have been delivered and invoiced. This grant will be closed soon.
- RSAF TJ-C03/06-25: Video Laryngoscopes and IV Pumps have been deployed to the field. This grant has been closed by Finance.
- SAFER EMW-2024-FF-01464: (SAFER EMW-2024-FF-01464: (Hiring) This grant has been accepted and we have held interviews for this staffing with an expected start-date of April 6, 2026.
- AFG EMW-2024-FG-01391: Equipment: This grant has been accepted. SBCA RIT packs have been distributed. Ward No-Smoke diesel exhaust filter installation is nearly complete. All three PPE washers/extractors have been delivered and installed at Louisa, Holly Grove, and Zion Crossroads fire stations.



Capital Projects:

- 481050 Command Vehicle: Three Chevrolet Silverado 2500HD trucks have been delivered to the dealer. Upfitting work has begun.
- 481051 Ambulances: Final inspection and acceptance for new FEMS ambulance was completed and it has been delivered to the vendor in Amelia, Va for upfitting. Lake Anna Rescue has started working with its chosen vendor for a custom spec ambulance.
- 482000 SCBA: Training on the new SCBAs has been completed, and they were distributed on Wednesday, February 11.
- 482080 Boat: Construction has been completed, and inspection and delivery are expected soon.
- 482091 Radio Tower: Site work is complete and Motorola radio system is live and operational. Final punch list items are being completed and coverage acceptance testing will follow.
- 482180 Ladder Truck: An order has been placed for a new Rosenbauer ladder truck that is due at the end of 2027. Crews traveled to the Rosenbauer factory in Minnesota in mid-January for pre-engineering visit.
- 482180 Brush Trucks: Two new brush trucks (one for New Bridge and one for Locust Creek VFD) in March 2026. Refurbishment/body replacement of brush truck for Zion Crossroads has been completed.

Other Updates:

- Completed major Motorola radio system software upgrades through the scheduled service and maintenance contract.
- Holly Grove Radio tower was placed in operational service. Now working on a plan for final adjustments, analog paging, and acceptance.
- Worked with VSP on a plan to install an interoperability radio console in dispatch server room.
- Attended Management Oversight Group (MOG) meeting.
- Q1 2026 Officer Summit held.
- Attended final Comp Plan Town Hall meeting at LCMS
- Traveled to PL Custom ambulance manufacturing plant for final inspection on new ambulance
- Held Super8 EMS CE training day on February 28, 2026. 50+ people in attendance from in and out of county
- Distributed new SCBAs to all stations and units
- Bumpass VFD took delivery of replacement tanker

Staffing, Recruitment, and Career Development:

- Current staffing levels: 82 of 86 positions filled.
- Completed first round panel interviews for upcoming hiring process and recruit academy (13 positions, 9 safer grant positions and 4 current openings).

Training Division:

- EMS Supervisors completed several on shift CEU's
- Finalized plan for a "Super8" EMS continuing education training day for January 31st. It had to be postponed until February 28th due to potential weather.
- Holly Grove Volunteer Rescue Squad continues their EMT-Basic program.
- High School Fire class continues 11 students.
- Finished Instructor I class in February.

Outreach & Fire Prevention:

- Fire and Life Safety Educator class attended/Passed
- Installed smoke detectors in two residences
