**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATIONS FOR K-9
DONATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Bien Venue Polar Bear Club recently gave a donation of \$1,726 to the Louisa County Sheriff's Office through its annual Polar Plunge, which will be used to benefit the K-9 dog program: and

WHEREAS, Vito's Italian Restaurant had a fundraiser that raised \$150 and Lawson Custom Homes contributed \$500 to the K-9 program; and

WHEREAS, Diane Thees, J. Clay Stiles III, and Donald Hall recently gave donations totaling \$375 to the K-9 program; and

WHEREAS, \$1,650 was recently collected as fees for the 2026 LCSO Bloodhound Seminar; and

WHEREAS, these donations were not included in the FY26 budget and need to be allocated at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 18th day of May 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorize a pass-through appropriation in the amount of \$4,401 to the Sheriff's Office K-9 Program (GL # 10031200-458760) for FY 2026 budget. The source of this funding is \$1,650 for training fees (GL# 0100R18-318913) and \$2,751 in private donations (GL # 0100R18-318130-CDON1).
