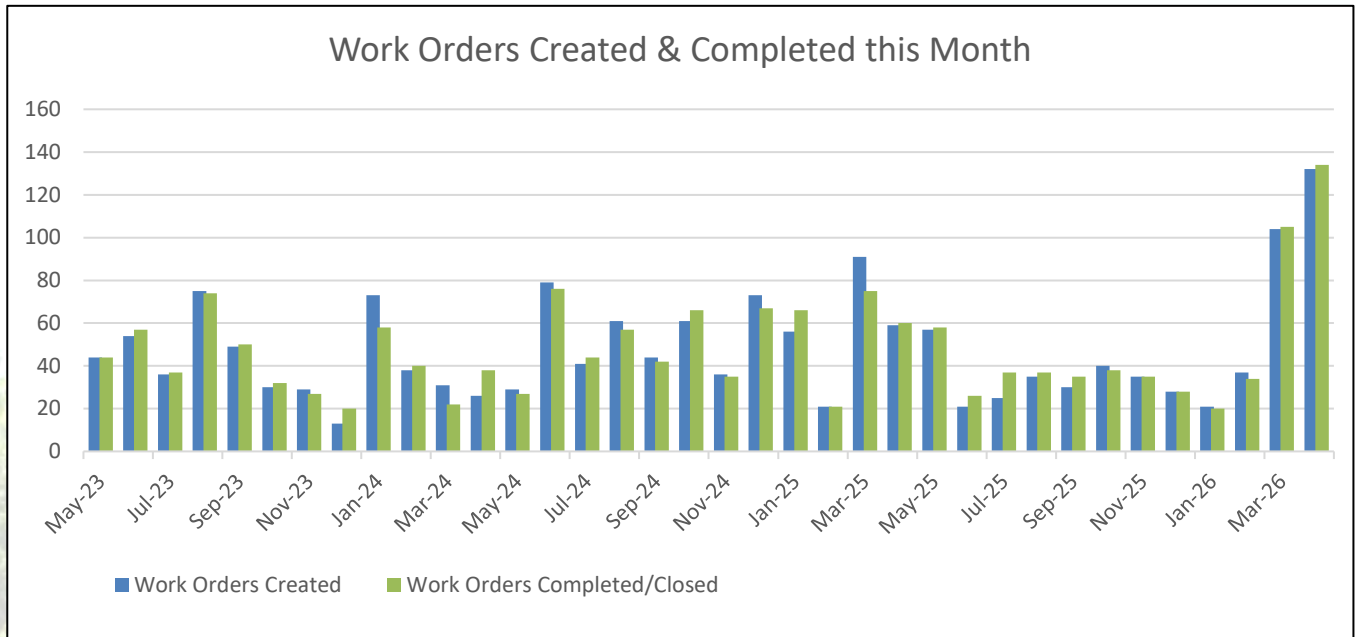

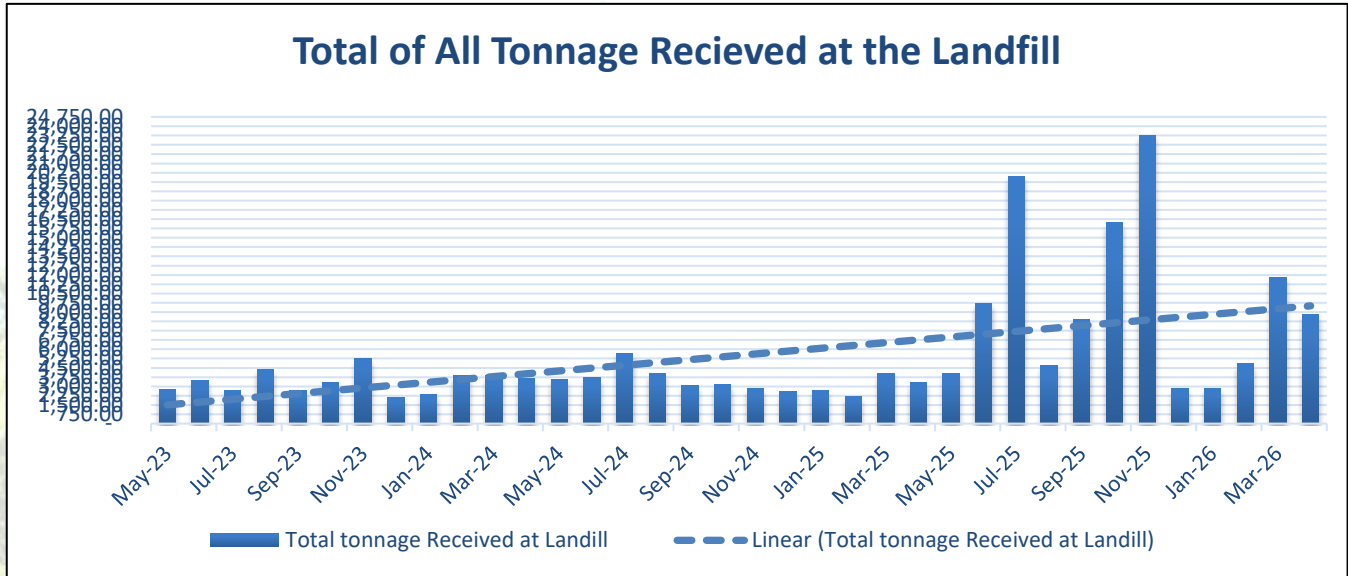

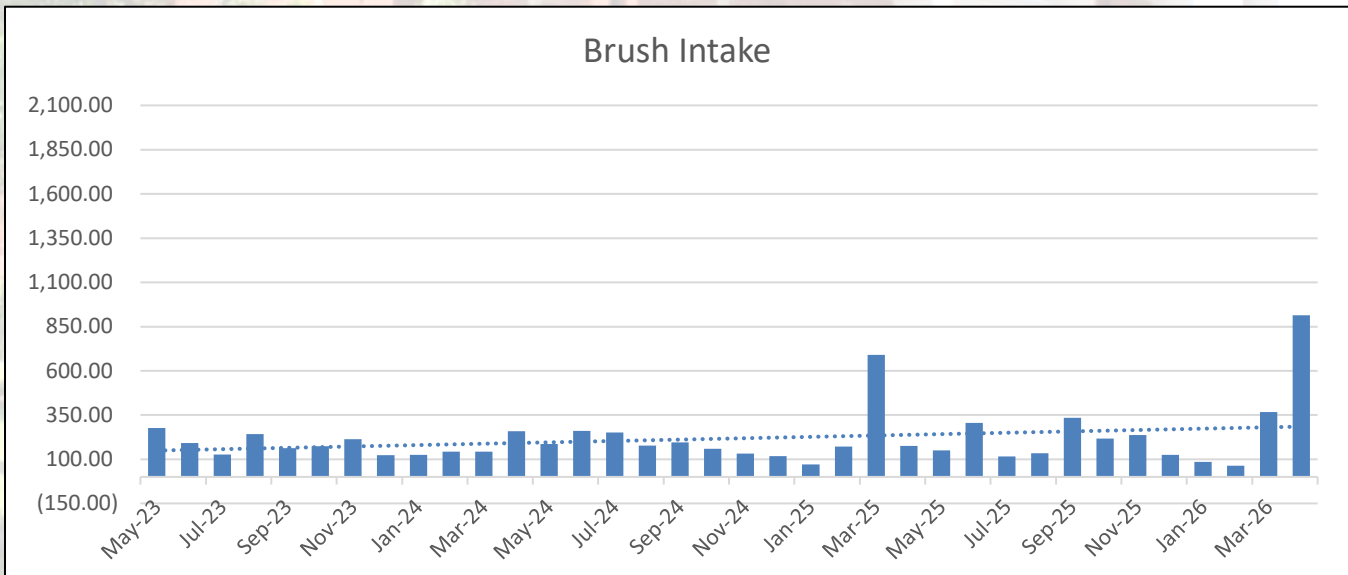
**Solid Waste**

The Landfill received 8,833.17 tons of materials last month. Of that tonnage, 3,115.41 tons were landfilled, and 4,544.74 tons were usable soil that was stockpiled for future use. The chart below shows the amount of material received at the landfill each month over the last three years.



**Brush**

The Landfill received 915.08 tons of brush last month. This large increase from previous months is due to brush being brought in from the Amazon project on Rte. 33. The chart below shows the tonnage of brush received at the landfill each month over the last three years.

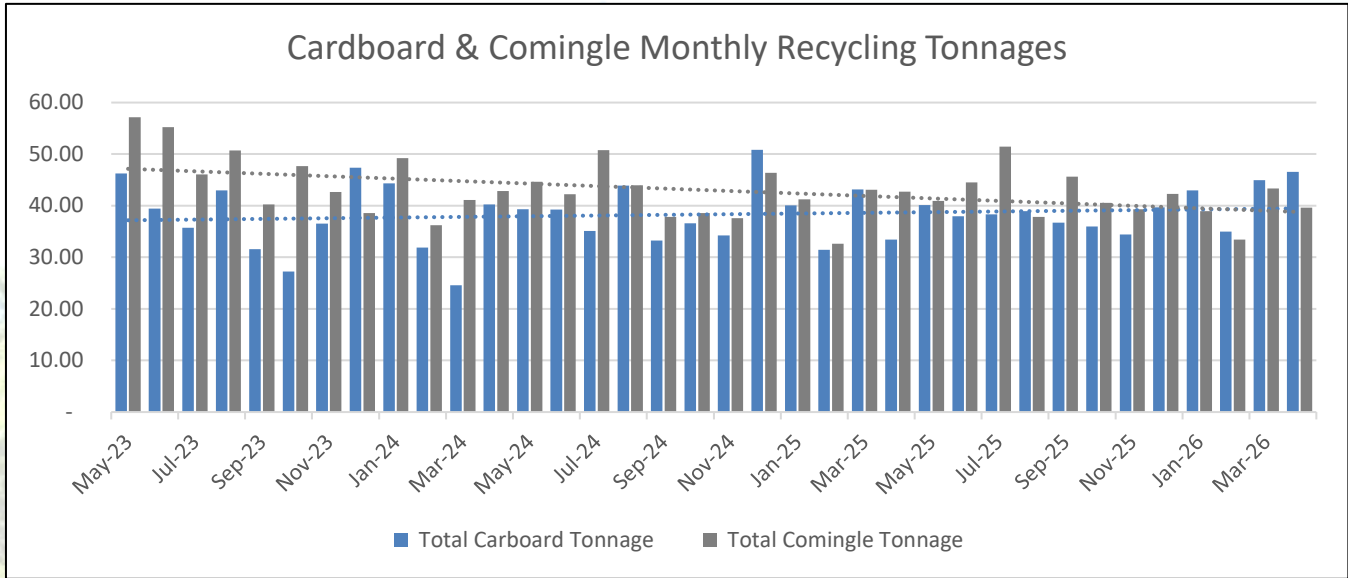

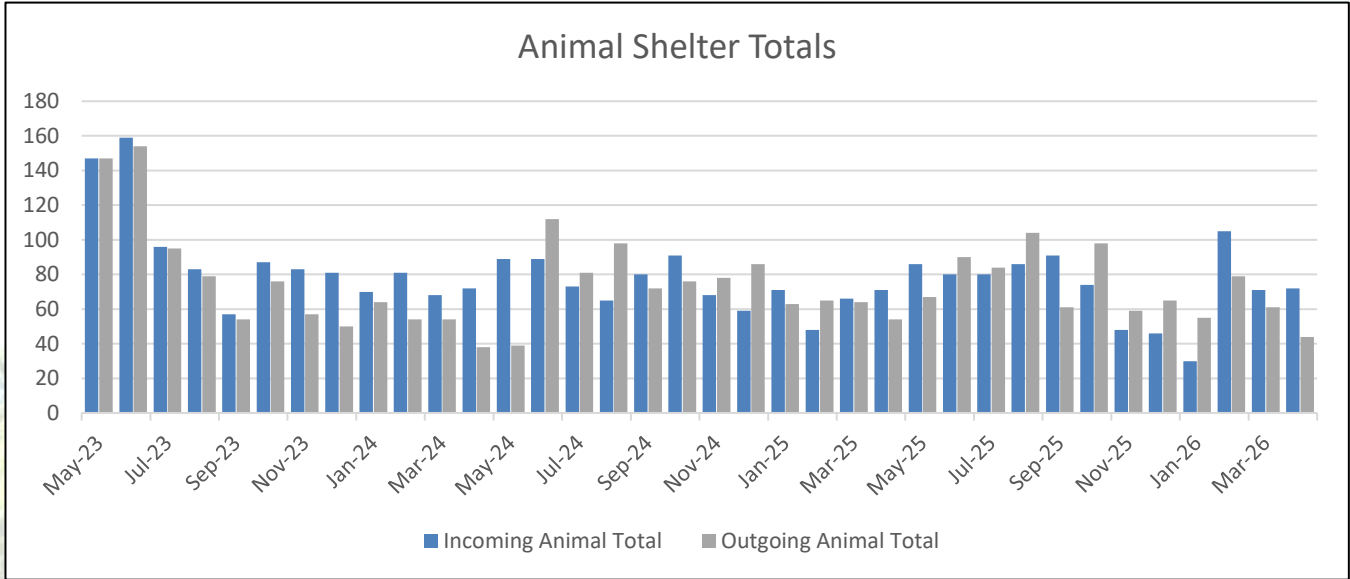
1. Labella has submitted revisions to Part “B” plan for the next phase of solid waste disposal (Cells 4A & 4B) at the Louisa County Sanitary Landfill as well as a request for a temporary increase in the allowable daily tonnage at the landfill to DEQ
2. The Five-Year Solid Waste Plan has been revised, updated and submitted to DEQ for review.
3. Completed plat & survey of lot line adjustments for purchase of tax maps 59-115 and 60-51 and leaving of remaining portion to current owner of parcel 59-115
4. The Louisa County Board of Supervisors completed closing and purchase of 450 acres of property adjacent to the Louisa County Sanitary Landfill that will add conservative figure of 250 additional years of life to the Louisa County Landfill.
5. The Landfill hosted a Household Hazardous Waste Day event on April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Two hundred thirty-three (233) vehicles participated in the drive through event to recycle household items that are not accepted on any other day at the Louisa County Sanitary Landfill.
6. Repairs are currently being made to the 2015 Caterpillar D6 Dozer: including replacement of the Hydrostatic drive pumps, and repair of the heating and cooling duct system.
