The Louisa County Farm Bureau Board of Directors met on **Wednesday, March 11** to discuss the proposed Valley Link Joshua Falls to Yeat 765kV transmission line that may cross Louisa County. After thorough discussion, the Board voted to oppose the project as currently proposed.

Below is the Board's **official statement**, which reflects our commitment to representing the long-term interests of our members and protecting working farms and forestland in Louisa County.

Louisa County Farm Bureau OPPOSES the Valley Link Joshua Falls to Yeat 765kv Transmission Line as it has been recently proposed.

Both proposed routes will have a detrimental impact on working farms and forests in Louisa County. These impacts will extend far beyond the construction phase of such lines, permanently altering the landscapes, revenue potential, and balance sheets of farmers along these routes who already face market uncertainties and typical seasonal challenges.

Louisa County Farm Bureau strongly urges Valley Link, and Dominion Energy in particular, to evaluate alternative routes for their new power line that do not damage the long-term interests of our farmers and forestland owners.
