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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LOUISA COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 70, TAXATION  
ARTICLE II-IN REAL ESTATE TAX RELIEF FOR THE ELDERLY OR TOTALLY  
DISABLED SECTION 70-35**

**WHEREAS**, Louisa County Code Chapter 70- Taxation-Article II- Real Estate Tax Relief for the Elderly or Totally Disabled Section 70-35, currently states that income levels between zero and fifty thousand dollars are eligible for tax relief; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed amendments will increase the income requirements to qualify for the aforementioned relief by ten percent, increasing the maximum income to \$55,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** on this 4th day of May, 2026, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby approves an amendment to Chapter 70, Taxation-Article II-Real Estate Tax Relief for the Elderly or Totally Disabled Section 70-35 increasing the income levels to qualify for relief by ten percent.
