The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following item(s) at 6:00 p.m., after regular business, on Monday, May 4, 2026, in the Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, 1 Woolfolk Ave., Louisa, Virginia:

**Public Hearing – VDOT Secondary Six-Year Plan and Secondary System Construction Budget for Louisa County, Virginia**

The Virginia Department of Transportation and the Board of Supervisors of Louisa County, in accordance with Section 33.2-331 of the Code of Virginia, will conduct a joint public hearing to discuss the Secondary Six-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2026/27 through 2031/32 in Louisa County and on the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2026/27. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed Plan and Budget.

Copies of the proposed Plan and Budget may be reviewed at the Louisa Residency Administrator's Office of the Virginia Department of Transportation, located at 3709 Davis Highway, Louisa, Virginia 23093, or at the Louisa County Administrator's Office located at 1 Woolfolk Avenue, Louisa, Virginia and online at [www.louisacounty.gov](http://www.louisacounty.gov)

All projects in the Secondary Six-Year Plan that are eligible for federal funds will be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which documents how Virginia will obligate federal transportation funds.

**Public Hearing - Amendments to Louisa County Code § 70-35, Tax Exemption for the Elderly and Disabled**

The proposed amendment to Louisa County Code Sections 70-35 will increase the income levels used to determine tax exemption eligibility for the tax exemption for the elderly and disabled by ten percent.

**Public Hearing - CUP2025-02 Zion United Methodist Church, Applicant/Owner; David McWilliams, Agent - Conditional Use Permit Request**

Zion United Methodist Church, Applicant/Owner; David McWilliams, Agent, request the request the issuance of a Conditional Use Permit to allow for a *Farmers market* in the Agricultural (A-2 GAOD), in accordance with Section 86-359. - Permitted uses with a conditional use permit within the growth area overlay district and Section 86-154 of Chapter 86 Land Development Regulations.

The property is located at the intersection of Columbia Road (Route 615), and Zion Road (Route 627) and is further identified as tax map parcel 51-6, in the Green Springs Election District. The subject property is located in the Zion Crossroads Growth Area and is designated as Low Density Residential and partially Mixed Use on the 2040 Louisa County Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map. The Planning Commission voted to forward a recommendation of approval on the requested application.
