**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PASS THROUGH APPROPRIATION FOR
INSURANCE PROCEEDS**

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$7,224.47 for insurance proceeds for a deer strike to a 2021 Ford Explorer VIN 6458 and \$7,077.82 for supplements to a 2023 Ford Explorer VIN 7866, and \$1,224.96 for a Ford Explorer VIN 7737 for additional damages; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$24,082 for damages from a March storm to the Wares Crossroads Refuse & Recycling Center, New Bridge Fire and EMS Station and to a Coupler at the Zion Crossroads Waste Water Plant; and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$94,356.32 in order to rebuild the canopy structure at the Green Springs Refuse Site which was damaged by a truck, and once the repairs have been completed and a certificate of completion filed, the remaining \$13,207.68 will be released to the County: and

WHEREAS, the County recently received \$6,280.32 for damages to a Ford Explorer damaged during a call; and

WHEREAS, funding for the above incidents was not included in the FY 2026 budget and needs to be appropriated at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, on this 3rd day of August 2026, the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorize a pass-through appropriation to the FY 2026 budget as

follows:

Accident Repairs	10043100-433120	\$118,438.32

The Source of this funding is Insurance Proceeds, GL 0100R18-318910-CINSC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes a payment of \$10,821 to the Louisa County Water Authority to reimburse them for the Sampler that was damaged at the Zion Crossroads Waste Water Treatment Plant that they paid to replace, GL # 10043100-433120.
